■ Preface



WaveELITE is a full-duplex communication system capable of **AES128 encryption**. <u>1</u> **Master and <u>5</u> Sub-Masters** are allowed to talk at the same time. Combining standard carry case and 6-pocket charger,
WaveELITE is highly portable and perfectly suits any occasion that requires max. 6 simultaneous talks.

■ Battery warning



- Fully charge the device before first use.
- Recharge the device regularly when battery is lower than 50%.
- Make sure 50% battery capacity is left before long-time storage and recharge it every 3 months.
- Stop using the device if overheating or abnormal battery life is found. Contact your supplier for further inspection or battery change.

■ Low battery



Charge the device as soon as possible when low-power signals show up.



■ Settings




It is recommended to define your device settings beforehand to ensure most appropriate performance of the device. Setting menu is shown below.

- **STEP 1.** Press and hold \vdots until setting menu shows up.
- **STEP 2.** Adjust each setting via <u>+</u> or <u>−</u> and confirm/leave with a press of :: .
- **STEP 3.** Select "Save & Exit" to leave when all adjustments are completed.

■ Different power-on way





■ Define your channel




Press and hold both $\underline{+}$ and $\underline{-}$ until above display shows up. Select an assigned channel via $\underline{+}$ or $\underline{-}$ and confirm/leave with a press of \vdots .

■ Grouping (型) before conversation



Make sure all devices are set at same channel before grouping.



- STEP 1. Press and hold <u>:</u> to power a Master on (७).
- STEP 2. Press and hold both <u>:</u> and <u>+</u> until grouping icon (□) shows up. Master's signal indicator starts to flash.
- **STEP 3.** Power Sub-Masters on (<u>o</u>) to receive Master's grouping signal.
- **STEP 4.** When signal indicators on Sub-Masters light up in steady blue, they are successfully grouped.
- STEP 5. Short press Master's \vdots to leave.
 Grouping icons (면) show up on all devices and you are ready now!

■ Adjust volume



Listening at high volume for long periods may damage your hearing.



Adjust your headphone volume via $\underline{+}$ or $\underline{-}$.

■ End conversation




Press and hold **<u>u</u>** till OFF shows up.

■ ATTENTION mode




Sub-Masters will temporarily be muted under ATTENTION mode.



Press and hold Master's $\underline{\Psi}$ until ATTENTION icon ((\bullet)) shows up. Talk indicators flash on all devices. To leave this mode, short press Master's $\underline{\Psi}$ again.

■ Back to factory default



To have the device be back to factory default, press and hold both \pm and - to power on (**७**).

■ Troubleshooting

Q: Why can't grouping (면) be executed?

A: Ensure all devices are set at same channel before grouping.

Q: Why can't I hear anything in the team?

A: Check followings.

- Headphone volume is correctly set.
- Headset is correctly plugged in.
- Ensure you are in the group while your Master was grouping (空).

Q: Why can't I talk in the team?

A: Check followings.

- Headphone volume is correctly set.
- Ensure you are not at ATTENTION mode.
- Ensure your talk button lights up. IF it doesn't, wait till any Sub-Master releases its talk right.

Q: Why can't the Master enter ATTENTION mode?

A: Make sure Master's talk mode is set at "PTB".
